

Deuteronomy 18: 15-22 Jesus: Prophet, Priest and King of Kings 8/6/2023

Intro: Most of the time a man may fulfill one office as a prophet, or priest, or a king, but Jesus fulfilled all 3.

Moses said that somewhere in the future a prophet will come who will be somewhat like Him and to be careful to listen to him in that time.

TEXT: Deut. 18: 15-22 Moses said to "hear Him!"

Moses: Deut. 34: 10- Close to God, no equal as a human prophet / **Exodus 33:11-** A friend of God/ Most humble man who ever lived. **Numbers 12:3**

Jesus: Abba Father! (In the garden). "My Father," He said on many occasions, in contradistinction to, "Our Father."

Matthew 11: 28-30 The wonderful approachability of Jesus! "Come to Me, all who are weary and heaven-laden, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For My yoke is easy and My burden is light."

Matthew 17: 1-5 On the mount of transfiguration there stood Moses, Elijah and Jesus. God the Father said, "This is My beloved Son, with whom I am well-pleased; listen to Him!"

Hebrews 1: 1-3 Final revelation of God is in Christ. Greater than the angels; greater than Moses. **Hebrews 3: 1-6**

John 5:45-47 Jesus knew He was The Prophet the people had been expecting.

THE PEOPLE: *****

John 6: 14 "This is truly the Prophet who is to come into the world."

John 7: 37-40 "This is certainly the Prophet."

PHILLIP: *****

John 1:45 "We have found Him of whom Moses in the Law and also the Prophets wrote- Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph."

STEVEN: *****

Acts 7: 37 "This is the Moses who said to the sons of Israel, ' God will raise up for you a prophet like me from your brethren.' "

PETER: *****

Acts 3: 17-23

JOHN THE BAPTIST: *****

John 1: 15- 23

Prophets were given the task of boldly speaking what God had already revealed, guiding us back to truth; and they could also predict future events of judgements and blessings. So there was "Forth- telling" and "Fore- telling." Jesus could speak with ultimate authority because of His deity.

Jesus foretold the future about many things as the ultimate prophet. He foretold His pending death and resurrection. He foretold Judas' betrayal; Peter's denial; the coming of the Holy Spirit; the persecution of His followers; the destruction of the temple; what the end times will look like. He foretold about His wonderful return and future blessings for the saved.
