Ex. 6-Flags. Conquistador. Miller Lite Beer " Great Taste - Less Filling!"

**God's sovereign plan is such a comfort!** Even though they fall away He has a plan of restoration for Israel if they will believe.

Ex. **Jeremiah 29:11.** We love to quote this one but the context is it will not happen for at least 70 years!

Ex. Parents scrape along and do without so they can help with college expenses while, at the present time, the 14 -year- old says he hates his mom and dad.

**The great scattering: Deut. 4:23-31**

**1st time:** Northern kingdom of Israel 722 B.C. Assyria

**2<sup>nd</sup> time:** Southern kingdom of Israel 586 B.C. Babylon

**3<sup>rd</sup> time:** Israel under Greek's rule Maccabees revolt 165 B.C.

**4<sup>th</sup> time:** Israel under the Roman's rule 63-70 A.D Jewish wars and temple destroy

**John 7: 33-36** A well-established fact of a "Dispersion" in Jesus day

The establishing of a secular Israel in 1948 does not fit the condition of a biblical regathering!

**Deut. 4:30-32 Ezekiel 36:19, 25-27 Jeremiah 31: 4,6,16**

**These, and many other passages, speak of much more than a mere physical regathering of Israel. The faithful remnant will be regathered to a land and given a new heart.**

Ex. Tyndale O.T. commentary P. 285

James 1:1 and I Peter 1: 1 both call Jewish and Gentile converts by terms that were exclusively for physical Israel.

**I Peter 1:1 2: 9-10** " It would seem perfectly obvious that James and Peter, leaders in the early church, are once again serving clear notice that God's commonwealth has taken on a new and expanded form by referring technical Jewish terminology to the church." Dr. William E. Bell

**Hebrews 11: 8-10 13-16** The ultimate land promise is the New Jerusalem!

**The Dispersion today is all God's people, throughout all the nations, bound by Jesus Christ as Lord, and all longing for home.**

**TEXT TODAY: Deuteronomy 30: 1-20 ( 30: 1-14 today)**

**30:6** The New Covenant with a new heart

Deuteronomy 30 is only truly fulfilled when remnant Jews, and Gentiles, are ready to say:

**Matthew 23: 37-39** "Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord."

**30: 11-14** Ultimately fulfilled in Christ (Not too far away or difficult to understand)

When they failed what was the remedy?

Is that remedy permanent and satisfying?

**Romans 10: 1-13** Just receive the work already done for you by Christ!

**Ex. John 6: 26-29** The final and complete revelation of God is in Christ!
