

**Deuteronomy 32:44-47 and 34:1-12 Moses Goes Home; No More Wandering 10/1/2023**

**INTRO: Read Deut. 32:44-47**

**FOCUS: 32:47a "For it is not an idle word for you; indeed it is your life."**

**We must absorb and be transformed by the word of God!**

**Isaiah 40:7-8** "The grass withers, the flower fades, when the breath of the Lord blows upon it; Surely the people are grass. The grass withers, the flower fades, but the word of our God stands forever."

**Matthew 4:4** "Man does not live by bread alone, but on every word that proceeds out of the mouth of God." (from Deut. 8:3)

**Colossians 3: 15-17** "... let the word of Christ richly dwell within you."

God's eternal word crosses the boundaries of this life to the next; and also flows from that future kingdom to the present to help us in time of need.

**As time went by, ritual and lip-service ruled over the reality of personally living in the Word. Similar to cultural Christianity in the U.S. today.**

**John 5:39-47** Moses will accuse them

**Matthew 23: 29-38** Trying to re- write their past

**Ex. Pastor's Appreciation Day-** All past pastor's came. One said, after all the praise of past pastors', " If they had treated me this good while I was here, I would have stayed!"

**Luke 24: 25-32 v.27** "... then beginning with Moses..."

**Genesis 3:15/ Numbers 21:9 Bronze serpent- John 3:14-16, 28 lift up on the cross/18:15 the prophet**

By prophecy, typology, sacrificial system, titles of deity of the Father given to the Son. These things and many, many more show the unfolding of the plan of God. Believe His Word!

**Deut. 34: 1-12** Moses goes home; to **wander** no more, or to **wonder** how it all comes out!

**QUESTION: Want something great to happen to you?** Be like Moses. Moses was great because he was humble; He only cared what God thought about things; He was predominately obedient.
